

# Farmers on 57th COVID-19 Safety Measures: Group Visits



All groups and staff at the farm are asked to follow the following safety measures to keep us safe, maintain our low-risk environment, help stem the spread of COVID-19 and keep farming fun!

## Health Checks

- Do not come to the farm if you are experiencing [COVID-19 symptoms](#), have returned from travels abroad in the last 14 days, or have been advised you had contact with someone that has COVID-19. This applies to all staff and visitors.

## Physical distancing

- Help keep us all safe by remembering to maintain physical distance (2-meters) between participant groups, staff and residents. On the paths, please yield to hospital staff and residents or walk on the lawn around them. Should a staff member need to provide care, they will wear a mask.
- Activities will discourage direct physical contact between members of a learning group or bubble.
- All activities are outdoors.

## Hand Washing

- A handwashing sink and soap are available on site.
- Hand-washing will happen upon arrival, before and after eating, and throughout the visit.
- Wash your hands with hot water and soap often for 20 seconds in duration.

## Sanitation and Disinfection

- Surfaces and tools are sanitized between use.
- Do not share tools unless they have been sanitized first.
- Food will only be handled by a farmer or the person eating it.
